# Methods of Evangelism

Over the last 2 Sunday mornings we have devoted the sermons to the important subject of evangelism. We have studied the basis for evangelism and the purpose of evangelism. Today we will continue that series with a lesson on the methods of evangelism. It is our prayer that this series will stir up our interest in evangelism in general and in evangelism at the upcoming Williamson County Fair in particular.

Evangelism is based on, and gets its authority from, the Great Commission (Mt. 28: 18-20; Mk. 16: 15-16; Lk. 24: 47; Acts 1: 8). That reminder will be the first point in today's lesson. In the second point I want to review how I became aware of the importance of evangelism and some of the ways of carrying out the evangelistic commission.

The third point, the major part of the sermon, is a study of 2 Timothy 2. There Paul says many important things to the young preacher Timothy. We will discuss five admonitions in particular. These are (1) "be strong" (2:1), (2) "teach others" (2: 2), (3) "suffer hardship" (2: 3), (4) "be diligent" (2: 15) and (5) be "the Lord's servant" (2: 24-26). All of these relate to evangelism in general and to personal evangelism in particular.

We are trying to impress on all of us the importance of evangelism. Not all of us can and will preach, but all of us can tell someone about Jesus. That is personal evangelism. It is one of the most important things you can do for the Lord and for others, as well as for yourself.

**~ Enthusiasm ~**

It has often been noted that the word enthusiasm comes from two Greek words, en and theos. The first word means "in" and the second is the Greek word for God. Therefore, some have suggested, enthusiasm comes from the idea of God within us. Webster defines the word as strong excitement or feeling and suggests that some synonyms are ardor, zeal, fervor and passion.

The early church was an enthusiastic church. It was faithful to the Lord in every way (Acts 2:42). It was evangelistic (Acts 5:42), even in times of terrible persecution (Acts 8:4). It assembled regularly for worship (Acts 2:42; Acts 20:7), and then it went out to tell others about Jesus (Acts 5:42).

Are we enthusiastic? As individual Christians? As a church? If not, why not? Southern Hills is a wonderful church. Our worship services are scriptural (Jn. 4:24), with great singing (Eph. 5:19; Col. 3:16), meaningful observance of the Lord's Supper (1 Cor. 11: 17-34), and faithful preaching of the word (2 Tim. 4:2) and prayer (1 Th. 5:17).
