Is There A Hell?

The Bible clearly teaches that there is a hell. It is both a place and a state or condition of existence. It is a place of punishment for the wicked and a state or condition of existence for the unredeemed. It is also eternal. Jesus said that the wicked "will go away into eternal punishment," while "the righteous will go into eternal life" (Mt. 25: 46). The same word describes both heaven and hell. "Both states will be without end" (Grudem).

It is noteworthy that Jesus said more about hell than anyone else in the Bible. The biblical word for hell is gehenna, which appears several times in the New Testament. (Mt. 23: 33, 5: 29-30; 10: 28; 18: 9; 23: 15, 5: 22; Mk. 9: 43, 45, 47; Lk. 12: 5; Js. 3: 6). All of these uses are by Jesus, except James 3: 5.

As one author wrote, "Hell is a place of eternal conscious punishment for the wicked." It is a place of "outer darkness," where "there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth" (Mt. 25: 30). It is "the eternal fire" (Mt. 24: 41), and a place of "eternal punishment" (Mt. 24: 46). It is "the unquenchable fire" (Mk. 9: 43, 48). "Scripture does indeed teach the eternal conscious punishment of the wicked."

Wayne Grudem wrote that hell "is emotionally one of the most difficult doctrines for Christians to affirm today. It also tends to be one of the first doctrines given up by people who are moving away from a commitment to the Bible as absolutely truthful in all that it affirms." But the doctrine is true. There is an eternal hell.
