Results of Evangelism

This is our fourth and final sermon in the series on evangelism. So far we have discussed the basis, purpose and methods of evangelism. Today we study the results of evangelism. Remember first the Great Commission to preach and teach the gospel of Christ (Mt. 28:18-20, Mk. 16:15-16, Lk. 24: 47 and Acts 1: 8). Why teach the gospel? Because it is "the power of God unto salvation" (Rom. 1:16).

Our commission comes from Christ, who has "all authority" (Mt. 28:18). Why does He have all authority? Because it was given to Him by His Father. Because He came "to seek and to save the lost" (Lk. 19:10). Because He came to give us an abundant life (Jn. 10:10). Because He is the Way, Truth and Life (Jn. 14:6). Because there is no other name given under heaven by which we must be saved (Acts 4:12). Because every spiritual blessing is in Christ (Eph. 1:3). Because He is God "manifested in the flesh" (1 Tim. 3:16; Jn. 1:1).

This commission from Christ was carried out by the early church and must be carried out by us. We will look at several examples of evangelism recorded in Acts. They will be listed on Power Point. From these we will see what evangelism was like and how it was practiced in the New Testament church. If evangelism was practiced by the first century church, why should it not be practiced by the twenty-first century church? It not only should be, it MUST be!
