CHRISTIAN HUMILITY

Jesus is our example in all things (1 Pt. 2: 21). He is our example of Christian humility (Jn. 13: 15). It was “before the Feast of the Passover” (Jn. 13: 1). The disciples had walked almost two miles from Bethany to Jerusalem. Their feet were dirty from the journey. Who would wash them?

No disciple offered to do the task. Jesus did. He got up from supper, laid aside His garments, girded Himself with a towel, poured water into a basin and washed the disciples’ feet and wiped them with the towel with which he had girded Himself.

Then Jesus asked, “Do you know what I have done to you?” He answered, “For I gave you an example that you also should do as I did to you.” An example of what? Christian humility. What is humility? It describes one who is “not proud, haughty, arrogant, or assertive” (Webster). The Greek words refer to lowliness of mind (Vine). The term describes one who is not determined to get his or her own way at the expense of another. “I say to everyone among you not to think more highly of himself than he ought to think” (Rom. 12: 3).

John 13 contains a great lesson in Christian humility. We are to serve God and man in the name of Jesus Christ. “For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many” (Mk. 10: 45).
