THE PLAN OF SALVATION

It is necessary that the preacher preach from time to time on the plan of salvation. Some will say that they have heard that before, and I hope they have. Some will say that they know all of that already. I hope so. However, in any audience there may be one or more persons who need to hear, believe and obey the gospel. The invitation, which includes the plan of salvation, is extended at every worship service at Southern Hills. But from time to time an entire sermon needs to be devoted to God's plan for the redemption and salvation of our souls. That plan will be preached today.

God's plan begins with the death, burial and resurrection of Christ (1 Cor. 15:1-4). As is often said, the gospel consists of facts to be believed, commands to be obeyed, and promises to be enjoyed. That plan continues with the jailer's question, "What must I do to be saved?" (Acts 16: 30). That question must be answered from the Bible, God's inspired word. The plan includes faith (Heb. 11: 1, 6), repentance (Lk. 13: 3, 5), confession (Rom. 10: 10) and baptism for the remission of sins (Acts. 2: 38).

Repentance and confession are steps in the plan of salvation on which everyone largely agrees. They areas of difference are faith and baptism. We must understand the difference between faith and faith only. And we must see that baptism is by immersion in order to receive the remission of sins. More on those points today.
