# THE GOSPEL



The gospel is the power of God unto salvation to everyone who believes and obeys it (Rom. 1: 16-17). God's purpose and grace have been revealed to us through the gospel (2 Tim. 1: 8-9). That which is revealed is that which is made known, manifested, or shown. The gospel was revealed by means of "the appearing of our Savior Jesus Christ."

Jesus appeared on earth as a man. As has often been said, He was at the same time "fully and completely God and fully and completely man." (See Philippians 2: 5-11 and 1 Timothy 3: 16). In His appearing and His life, death, resurrection, ascension and work He revealed the will of God for us through the gospel.

How could Jesus do that? What qualified Him to do that? Who is He? He is the Savior (Mt. 1: 21; Lk. 19: 10). The Savior is the Deliverer, the One who delivers or saves us from sin. He is Jesus, the name that means Savior or Deliverer. He is the Christ or Messiah, God's Anointed One (Mt. 16: 16). None of that has changed, nor will it ever (Jn. 14: 6; Acts 4: 12).

What has Jesus done? (1) He has abolished death. Granted, death passes to all (Heb. 9: 27; Rom. 5: 12). But death has already been defeated by the resurrection of Christ (Jn. 5: 28-29; 1 Cor. 15: 54-55). (2) He has also brought life and immortality to light (Jn. 10: 10; Jn. 11: 25-26). How has all of this been revealed? Through the gospel.
