Exhort One another Daily

When Hebrews was written Christians were suffering terribly for their faith. It was for this reason that the author wanted to warn them to not turn from God. He said, **“Beware, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief in departing from the living God; but exhort one another daily, while it is called ‘Today,’ lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin”** (Hebrews 3:12, 13). There is no question that it would be difficult to remain faithful in times of persecution. Sin has a way of deceiving us and if we’re not careful one might think it more advantageous to turn from Christianity. Yet the Hebrew author instructed these Christians to exhort one another to keep this from happening. To exhort simply means to comfort or encourage. Thus, he highlighted one of the many important reasons we should look for ways to encourage each other. Remaining faithful to God is not always easy. Let us always look for ways to encourage each other in the faith.
