## THE PLAN OF SALVATION

After four sermons on evangelism, and after a week and more of diligent work at the fair booth, it might be good to review the plan of salvation. Hopefully, because of our work at the fair and for other reasons, we will have opportunities to teach interested persons the will of God for their salvation.

First in any discussion of salvation are the PRELIMINARIES. These include God (1 Th. 1:9; Gen. 1:1; Acts 17:24-28), Christ (Mt. 3:17; Mt. 17:5; Rom. 1:4), the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:38; Eph 1: 13-14), and the gospel (Rom. 1: 16-17; Jn. 17: 17; Eph. 1:13).

This is followed by a study of the PLAN of salvation as taught in the Bible. This includes hearing the gospel (Rom. 10: 17), believing the gospel (Heb. 11: 1, 6; Jn. 8: 24), repenting of sins (Lk. 13: 3, 5; Acts 2: 38; 2 Pet. 3: 9), confessing our faith in Christ (Rom. 10: 10), and being baptized by immersion in order to receive the remission of sins (Mt. 28: 18-20; Mk. 16: 15-16; Jn. 3: 1-5; Acts 2: 38; Rom. 6: 1-4; Gal. 3: 26-27).

Finally, there is the POINT. When we are baptized into Christ our sins are forgiven (Acts 2: 38; Acts 22: 16). We are given a new life (Rom. 6: 4). We become a new creature or a new creation (2 Cor. 5: 17). We are made new persons in Christ (Eph. 4: 22-24). We are "born anew" (Jn. 3: 1-5).

These points will help us teach others the will of God. Please become a personal evangelist for Christ. It is a joyous experience!
