Repentance Leading to Salvation

Jesus once said “**unless you repent you will all likewise perish**” (Luke 13:3). Obviously, His statement makes repentance a very important subject. Unfortunately, many do not understand the meaning of what Jesus said because they fail to understand what repentance is. A dictionary would give a definition like “to change one’s life, based on complete change of attitude and thought concerning sin and righteousness” (*Dictionary of Biblical Languages*). Paul helped us understand repentance when he wrote: “**Now I rejoice, not that you were made sorry, but that your sorrow led to repentance. For you were made sorry in a godly manner, that you might suffer loss from us in nothing. For godly sorrow produces repentance leading to salvation, not to be regretted; but the sorrow of the world produces death**” (II Corinthians 7:9, 10). Notice that Paul didn’t say that sorrow was repentance; but he said sorrow can produce repentance. So, we repent when we become sorrowful for our sinful behavior and allow that sorrow to change our actions. Jesus said that unless we do that...we all will perish. Paul, on the other hand, spoke of repentance as “leading to salvation”. Let us all make sure that we repent so that we will have life.
