## \* REPENTANCE \*

Over the last two months (July and August) we have discussed three very important topics: evangelism, the plan of salvation and the Christian life. Today and two weeks from today we want to study two more subjects that are a part of the plan of salvation: repentance and baptism. Why do we do this? For two reasons. One, because there are people in any and every audience who need to obey the gospel of Christ. Two, because after the series on evangelism we hope many of us will be teaching the gospel to others.

What is repentance? The word basically means to change or turn. It is a change of heart, mind, will and attitude in reference to sin that leads to and results in a change or reformation of the life. Today's sermon will look at three points about repentance. First, repentance is COMMANDED (Acts 2: 38; 2 Pt. 3: 9). Second, our JUDGMENT will be based in part on our repentance (Acts 17: 30-31). Third, we must either repent or PERISH (Lk. 13: 1-5).

It has often been suggested that our repentance must be as public as our sin. If our sin is a private sin, we can repent of it and pray to God for forgiveness. But if it is a public sin, one known about by others, it demands a public confession. This is in keeping with James 5:16: "Therefore, confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another so that you may be healed." (See Acts 8: 18-24).
