What is the providence of God? Why is it such an important topic? First, what does the word mean? It comes from the Latin word "videre" and the prefix "pro." The word and prefix combined mean to look ahead, to foresee, to plan in advance. It also means to carry out the plan.

The dictionary defines the word providence as "the foreseeing care and guardianship of God over His creatures." It adds that providence is "a manifestation of divine care or direction." Another source states that the doctrine says that the world is not ruled by chance or fate, but by the living God.

The Bible clearly teaches the providence of God. In the Old Testament there is the work of the providence of God in the lives of such people as Joseph and Esther (Gen. 45:5-8; Esther 4:13-14). In the New Testament there are such passages as Romans 8:28-39. Of particular importance in the lesson this morning is Romans 8:28. It teaches five facts.

(1) There is the CALL of God. Christians are "the called according to His purpose." (2) There is the CONFIDENCE we can have in God. "And we know." (3) There is the COMPLETENESS of God's providential work. "All things." (4) There is the COOPERATION. "All things work together for good." (5) There is the CONDITION. This promise is "to those who love God." Here are five facts about the providence of God in one great verse.
