## WHY STUDY THE BIBLE?

Why does Southern Hills study the Bible in its worship services and Bible classes? Why are we always encouraging members and others to stay for Bible classes? Why do we encourage individuals and families to study the Bible at home? Because the Bible is the inspired, inerrant, infallible, all-sufficient and completely and totally authoritative word of the living God (2 Tim. 3: 16-17).

It is the Bible that tells us that God loved us enough to send His Son to die for our sins and be raised for our justification (Jn. 3: 16-17; Rom. 4: 25). It is God's inspired word that guides us (Ps. 119: 105). God's word is truth (Jn. 17: 17). It is the truth of God's word that makes us free (Jn. 8: 31-32). The Holy Spirit guided the Bible writers into "all the truth" (Jn. 16: 13). That truth, the revealed will of God, guides, instructs and encourages us. The word of God stands as written; it is not to be changed (Mt. 4: 4, 7, 10).

The Bible records the good news of the gospel of salvation. That is the gospel that saves us (1 Cor. 15: 2; Rom. 1: 16-17). At the heart of the gospel is the death, burial and resurrection of Christ (1 Cor. 15: 3-4). Does one have to believe and obey the gospel to be saved? Yes! (Rom. 1: 16-17; Mk. 16: 15-16; 2 Thess. 1: 8; 1 Pet. 4: 17; 1 Pet. 1: 22-25; James 1: 18).

Do we see why the Bible is important and why it is necessary both to study it and live by it?
