The Bible is the inspired, inerrant, infallible and all-sufficient word of the living and true God who created and sustains the heavens and the earth (Gen. 1:1; 1 Th. 1:9). Here are four reasons why we know that is true. All four are found in 2 Timothy 3:16-17.

One, the Bible affirms that it is inspired by God. "All Scripture is inspired by God" (NASB). Or as the ESV has it, "All Scripture is breathed out by God." God is its source, origin and author. The Bible is God's inspired word to all mankind.

Two, the Bible is "profitable" or useful. For what? "For teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness." The Bible is most useful in matters that determine our spiritual well-being and eternal destiny.

Three, the Bible makes us "complete." It gives us everything we need to show us the way to heaven (Ps. 119:105; Jn. 14:6). It makes Christians more than competent or adequate; it makes us complete. It makes us able to meet all the demands placed on us.

Four, the Bible makes us "thoroughly equipped for every good work." The Bible is inspired by God in order that we may be fitted or furnished for all that Christians are to be and do.

God, in His infinite love, grace and mercy, has given us His inspired word, the Bible. It gives us the guidance we need to become Christians and live faithful Christian lives.
