❖ COMMITMENT ❖

Jesus said, "If anyone wishes to come after Me, he must deny himself, and take up his cross and follow Me" (Mt. 16: 24). These are three fundamental steps to commitment to Christ: (1) self-denial, (2) cross-bearing, and (3) following Him. They demand the very best that we have to offer to Christ.

But some will object that they have already made such a commitment. They made it when they obeyed the gospel. I do not doubt that at all. What I am encouraging us to do is to renew our commitment to our Lord.

What are some ways in which we can renew our commitment to Christ? Here are a few. (1) Read the Bible daily, and study it when possible. (2) Pray daily, preferably more than once. (3) Attend all of the worship services and Bible study periods offered by the church. (4) Talk to someone about Jesus. There are many other ways in which we can renew our commitment to the Lord. We can begin with these.
