What is salvation? Why is salvation important? How do we receive salvation? Salvation is freedom or deliverance from sin. What is sin? It is disobedience and rebellion against God, His Son, and His inspired word. The most common Greek word for sin means "to miss the mark". When we sin, we fail to live according to God's will as that will is revealed to us in His inspired word.

To be saved is to be redeemed or rescued from sin. How is that done? Through the blood of Christ shed on Calvary's cross (Ephesians 1:7; Colossians 1:14; Matthew 26:28; Hebrews 9:12; Hebrews 9:22). To be saved is to have the burden of sin lifted from us (Matthew 11:28-30). To be saved is to be given a new life in Christ (Romans 6:1-4). It is to have the hope of eternal life (John 14:1-3). All of these are reasons (among others) why salvation is important.

Finally, how do we receive salvation? By the blood of Christ. But it also comes by obedience to the gospel of Christ (Mark 16:16). We must hear the gospel (Romans 10:17), respond to what we hear in faith (Hebrews 11:1, 6), turn from our sins in repentance (Luke 13:1-5), confess the name of Christ (Romans 10:10) and be immersed for the remission of our sins (Acts 2:38). By that we are born again (John 3:1-5) and added to Christ's church (Acts 2:47).

In short, we become Christians, saved from our past sins by Christ through obedience to the gospel.
