HOW MANY GOSPELS?

Today I begin my twenty-first year as preaching minister of the Southern Hills Church of Christ. The first two decades have been a period of great joy and satisfaction. As we begin our twenty-first year of serving Christ together it is very appropriate that our sermon this morning deals with the necessity of preaching the pure gospel of Christ. We take as our text Galatians 1:6-10.

What does the Apostle Paul teach here by the inspiration of God (2 Tim. 3:16-17)? First, he analyzes the SITUATION among the churches of Galatia. There were those who were "turning away so soon from Him who called you in the grace of Christ to a different gospel" (v.6). It was what someone called "a counterfeit gospel." It was "a different gospel--which is really no gospel at all" (NIV).

Second, what was the SOURCE of the problem? "There are some who trouble you and want to pervert the gospel of Christ" (v.7). These false teachers were "disturbing" the churches (NASB). How? By perverting the gospel of Christ. They were (1) perverting the gospel and thereby (2) disturbing the churches.

Third, what was the SOLUTION to the problem? To pervert the pure gospel was/is to be "accursed." Anyone, even Paul himself or an angel from heaven, who perverted the gospel was "anathema" (ASV). The word indicates a curse. It means to incur "the disfavor of Jehovah." Paul was not seeking the favor of men, nor striving to please men, but God. So must we!
