FAITH

The Bible states, "Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen" (Hebrews 11:1). It adds, "But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him" (Hebrews 11:6). Jesus added, "If you do not believe that I am He, you will die in your sins" (John 8:24).

The word refers to belief, conviction, trust and reliance on God, His Son and His word. It means that we trust God, we believe in Who He is, and we rely on Him to be with us and guide us through His word (Psalm 119:105) and by His providential care (Romans 8:28).

The Bible says that we are "justified by faith" (Romans 5:1), and that "We walk by Faith, not by sight" (2 Corinthians 5:7). There are examples in the Bible of men and women who walked by faith. In the Old Testament there is Abraham, who is "the father of the faithful." Abraham was told to leave his home to go to a land he had never seen. He journeyed 1,300 miles to Canaan because of his trust in God.

In the New Testament there is Paul, who wrote, "I know whom I have believed and am persuaded that He is able to keep what I have committed to Him until that Day" (2 Timothy 1:12). As the Hebrews writer put it, "And what more shall I say?" (Hebrews 11:32).
