What is joy? Why should it be a part of the Christian life? It is “the emotion of great delight or happiness caused by something good or satisfying’ (RHCD). One source calls it delight in the good, and cites what the angel said in Luke 2:10. “I bring you good tidings of great joy which will be to all people.” Why? “For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord.” What could cause greater joy than that?

As the same source says, “Scripture abounds with references to joy and rejoicing.” One such place where there is a great emphasis on joy is in Paul’s letter to the Philippians. That is one of the apostle’s “prison epistles,” written while he was under house arrest in Rome (Acts 28:16, 30-31). Remember how many things Paul continued to suffer for the cause of Christ (2 Corinthians 11:22-28).

Yet Paul could write about joy and rejoicing in his letter to the Philippians. The two words appear fourteen times in the four chapters of the letter (NKJV). He encourages them to “rejoice in the Lord” (3:1; 4:4). Joy should be a vital part of every Christian’s life.

That does not mean that bad things do not happen to good people, even Christians. Of course, they do. Sometimes we experience physical, emotional or other kinds of reversals. But we can always have that sense of joy that comes to us from God through Jesus Christ because we are His.
