God wants all and only good things for His children. For example, He wants us to grow in the faith (Ephesians 4:11-13; 2 Peter 3:17-18). How do we do that? By Bible reading and study (1 Peter 3:15; 2 Timothy 2:15), by faithful worship of Him (Hebrews 10:25), by prayer (1 Thessalonians 5:17), and by acts of service done in His name (Matthew 25:31-46; Galatians 6:10).

Secondly, God wants us to glorify Him in all that we are and do. We are to do all that we do "to the glory of God" (1 Corinthians 10:31). Whatever we do is to be done "in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through Him to God the Father" (Colossians 3:17).

Third, God wants us to go to heaven to live with Him eternally. While the Bible may not tell us everything we would like to know about that eternal home, it does tell us enough to let us know that heaven is a wonderful and beautiful place.

Think, for example, of the beautiful description of heaven in Revelation chapters 21 and 22. It is a unique place (21:1), a pure place (21:2), a place where God is present (21:3), and a place with no tears, death, mourning, crying or pain (21:4). And it will be our eternal home (21:6-7).

Finally, heaven is promised by Jesus (John 14:1-3). Heaven is a permanent place (14:2), prepared for us by Christ (14:2), and promised to us by Him (14:3). As the hymn says, "How beautiful heaven must be!"
