We must never overlook or ignore the central place that evangelism must have in the Lord's church. Why is its place so important? First, it is important because our Lord commanded us to evangelize (Matthew 28:18-20; Mark 16:15-16; Luke 24:47). God does not command us to do what we cannot do. We are commanded to evangelize; we can evangelize; we must evangelize. We must evangelize because Christ commanded us to evangelize.

Second, we must evangelize because the New Testament church, the model church, evangelized. As Christians told others about Christ, people were added to the church (Acts 2:47). Soon people were "increasingly added to the Lord" (Acts 5:14). As the church was "scattered" after the death of Stephen, the word was preached (Acts 8:4). There are many other examples of evangelism in the New Testament, including the people of Samaria (Acts 8), Cornelius and his household (Acts 10 and 11), Lydia and her household and the jailer and his household (Acts 16), Saul of Tarsus (Acts 9, 22, 26), Crispus and the Corinthians (Acts 18:8), and the twelve disciples of John the Baptist (Acts 19). The model church constantly evangelized.

Third, there is certainly a critical need for evangelism today (Matthew 9:37; Luke 10:2; John 4:35). As Ivan Stewart, an outstanding personal evangelist, said, " 'Go ye' means 'Go me'." We must all be evangelists. There is no more important work in the Lord's church. The challenges before us are tremendous. But so are the opportunities!
