## GOSPEL OBEDIENCE

Why do we preach and teach the gospel of Christ? Because obedience to the gospel is essential to our salvation. The gospel, God's good news, begins with the death, burial and resurrection of Christ (1 Cor. 15: 3-4). It is the same gospel that Paul preached and the Corinthians received, in which they stood, and by which they were saved if they held fast to it. It is the same gospel that saves men today.

It is through the gospel that men are called to salvation (2 Thess. 2: 13-14). How and why does the gospel lead to our salvation? Because it is "the power of God to salvation" (Rom. 1: 16-17). All men must understand that it is necessary to obey the gospel of Christ in order to be saved from sin and have the hope of eternal life (2 Thess. 1: 3-10; 1 Pt. 4: 17).

The gospel is the power of God to save us for two reasons. First, because it comes from God (Rom. 1: 16). Second, because it is the good news about Jesus Christ and what He has done and continues to do for us (Rom. 1: 16).

Therefore, to be saved we must obey the gospel of Christ. How do we do that? By hearing the gospel taught (Rom. 10: 17), responding in faith (Rom. 10: 17; Heb. 11: 1, 6; Jn. 8: 24), repenting of our sins (Lk. 13: 1-5; Acts 17: 30-31), confessing His name (Rom. 10: 10), and being immersed for the remission of sins (Acts 2: 38). Please obey the gospel today!
