~Today 3rd & 4th grade team will have puppet practice. There will be NO practice for other teams (5th-7th & 8th-12th) due to CYC.

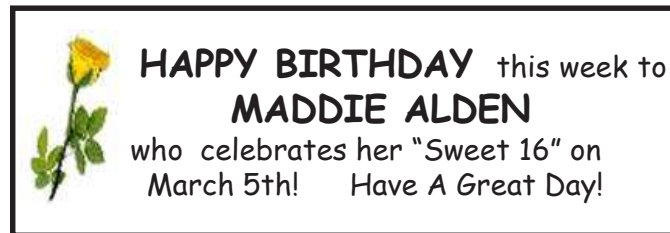


### HORIZONS at FHU

## "Who Is This?"

In Luke 7 a woman washed the feet of Jesus. Then the Lord said to her, "Your sins are forgiven" (v. 48). This prompted the people who sat at the table with Jesus to ask, "Who is this who even forgives sins?" (v. 49). In Luke 5 Jesus healed the paralytic man who had been let down through the roof to where He was. Jesus said to him, "Man, your sins are forgiven you" (v. 20). So the scribes and Pharisees accused Jesus of blasphemies saying, "Who can forgive sins but God alone?" (v. 21).

In recent weeks we have seen the power and authority of Jesus over nature, disease, demons and death. Today we look at a passage (Luke 5: 17-26) in which Luke connects power over disease with power over sin. We will study (1) the setting (5: 7), (2) the scene (5:18-19), (3) the sins forgiven (5:20), (4) the scribes' reaction (5:21), and (5) Jesus as the Son of Man (5:22-26).

This series of lessons, which studied some of the miracles performed by Jesus, shows, as John affirms, that Jesus is the Son of God (Jn. 20: 30-31). He is the Lamb of God (Jn. 1: 29). He is the Savior of the world (1 Jn. 4: 14). He is not one among many possible saviors, He is, as He said, "the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me" (Jn. 14: 6).

This Wednesday night Ron Maynard will be here to teach a class on parenting. It will meet in the fellowship hall after the devotional. All who are interested are encouraged to attend the class. Ron will be with us three successive Wednesday nights, March 4, 11 and 18.
