UNITY

“Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity” (Psalm 133:1). What is unity? The word refers to being united, to being one. Unity as one in Christ is one of the most important doctrines in the Bible. Here are two reasons why unity is important.

One, Christ prayed for unity. John 17 records that prayer. Jesus begins by praying for His apostles (John 17:1-19). But beginning in John 17:20 Jesus is praying for all believers in Him everywhere for all time, including us. We come to believe on and obey Jesus through the reading and study of God’s Word (v. 20).

Jesus’ prayer is “that all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me and I in You” (John 17:21). Unity in Christ will help the world believe that God sent His Son. Again, Jesus prays, “That they may be one just as We are one” (John 17:22). Yet again He prays “that they may be made perfect in one” (John 17:23).

Two, Paul pleaded for unity. To the Corinthians he wrote, “Now I plead with you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment” (I Corinthians 1:10).

Jesus prayed for unity and Paul pleaded for unity. Then the unity of all believers as one in Christ must be extremely important.
