RESURRECTION

Job asked, "If a man dies, shall he live again?" (Job 14: 14). The answer is "Yes!" There will be a resurrection of the dead (Jn. 5: 28-29). Our belief is based on the fact that God raised His Son, Jesus, from the dead.

That is the heart of the argument for the resurrection in 1 Corinthians 15. There Paul refers to the gospel (vs. 1-2). At the heart of the gospel is the death, burial and resurrection of Christ (vs. 3-4). The resurrected Jesus was seen by eyewitnesses (vs. 5-11). The resurrection chapter is divided into three parts: the fact of the resurrection (vs. 1-34), the manner of the resurrection (vs. 35-49) and the assurance of the resurrection (vs. 50-58).

As Michael Green wrote, "The resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead is the cornerstone of Christianity." The problem at Corinth was that some did not believe in resurrection. So Paul lists several consequences of this non-belief. "If there is no resurrection of the dead, then Christ is not risen" (v. 13). "If Christ is not risen, then our preaching is vain and your faith is also vain" (vs. 14). "We are found false witnesses of God" (v. 15). Again, "then Christ is not risen (v. 16). "Your faith is futile; you are still in your sins" (v. 17). "Those who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished" (v. 18). "We are of all men the most pitiable" (v. 19). Jesus was raised from the dead (Rom. 1: 4). So will we be!
