## The Promise of The Cross

Last Sunday we began a study of the cross of Christ. We saw that Jesus suffered for us and bore our sins in His body on the cross (1 Pt. 2: 21, 24). We looked at modern man's dilemma. Man is lost without Christ and His gospel (Jn. 14:6; Lk. 19:10; Acts 4:12; Eph. 1:7; Rom. 1:16). We examined several prophecies that spoke of the death of Christ (Gen. 3:15; Psalm 22; Isaiah 53). We reviewed some statements made by Jesus that confirmed that He fulfilled the Old Testament prophecies (Luke 24:25-27, 44-47).

This morning we will study some prophetic statements Jesus made about His death (Mark 8:31, 9:30-31, 10:32-34). Then we will look at several statements He made about His "hour" or "time," and how these statements refer to His death on the cross. Then we will see that the Bible teaches that the death of Jesus on Calvary was according to God's will (Heb. 10:7). Finally we will apply this to what the Bible teaches about our salvation.

Tonight we will continue the study we started last week about the Bible being the basis for our belief. We will look at some of the statements Jesus made about the word of God. We will see that the Scriptures truly do testify of Jesus (Jn. 5:39). We will review some of the things Jesus said about the Scriptures. From these verses we will draw several very important conclusions about God's word. Please be with us!
