WHEN TRIALS COME

We saw last Sunday that trials come (Js. 1: 1-4). Today we study what Christians are to do when they come. First, we must have the wisdom to deal with trials (Js. 1: 5). If we lack such wisdom we are to "ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach." What will God do? "And it will be given to Him." God will help us face the trials of life.

However, we must "ask in faith" (1: 6). We know what faith is (Heb. 11: 1, 6). Further, we must ask "with no doubting." He who doubts is "like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind." What will such a person receive from the Lord? "Let not that man suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord" (1: 7). Why? Because "he is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways" (1: 7).

The next three verses emphasize what God through Christ does for us. First, the lowly brother glories in his exaltation. How is he exalted? By God through Christ in obedience to His gospel (1: 9). What does the rich do? He glories in his humiliation. Why? Because his glory is not in his riches, but in Christ (1: 10).

What is the rich man like without Christ? He is "as a flower of the field" (1: 11). What will happen to him? "He will pass away." He will "fade away in his pursuits." The God who saves us through Christ gives us the wisdom to overcome the trials that come.
