## New Testament Preaching

At the heart of New Testament preaching is the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus Christ (1 Cor. 15: 1-4). In the very first recorded gospel sermon Peter preached that Jesus had been nailed to a cross, put to death and raised again by God (Acts 2: 23-24). In Peter's second sermon he preached that the Prince of life (Jesus) had been put to death and raised from the dead by God (Acts 3:15). Later, Peter and John were accused of "teaching the people and proclaiming in Jesus the resurrection from the dead" (Acts 4: 2). The very next day in a hearing before the Sanhedrin Peter preached that they had crucified Jesus and God had raised Him from the dead (Acts 4: 10). At the house of Cornelius Peter preached that the Jews put Jesus to death by hanging Him on a cross, but God raised Him up on the third day (Acts 10: 39-40).

Immediately after Paul's conversion he preached that Jesus is the Son of God (Acts 9: 20). At Pisidian Antioch Paul preached that the Jews had Jesus executed, taken down from the cross and laid in a tomb. But He was raised from the dead by God (Acts 13: 29-30). At Thessalonica Paul preached "that the Christ had to suffer and rise again from the dead" (Acts 17: 3). In the sermon before the Aeropagus on Mars Hill in Athens Paul preached that God had raised Jesus from the dead (Acts 17: 31).

At the heart of biblical preaching is--and must be--the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus our Lord, who is the Christ.
