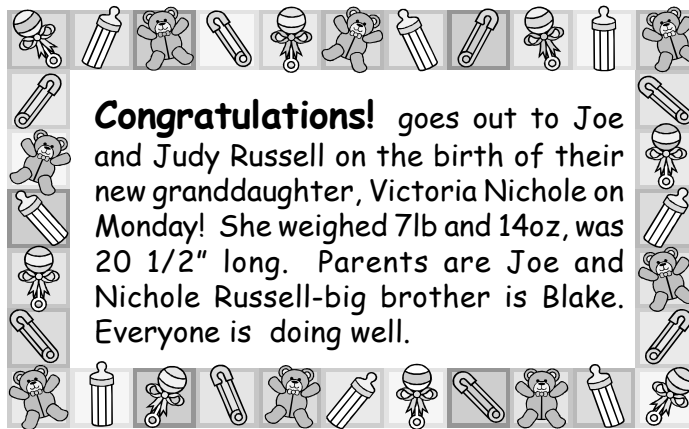
ANNOUNCEMENTS

On Sunday morning, April 13, Ron Maynard, who is with the Fishers of Men program, will speak to a combined group of classes in the auditorium at the Bible School hour. Fishers of Men is a program Southern Hills has supported for several years. In fact, Ron taught a series of Fishers of Men classes here a few years ago. Ron is always excited and enthusiastic about his work, and we look forward to hearing him.

On Sunday, April 27, Dr. William (Billy) R. Smith, Dean of the School of Biblical Studies at Freed-Hardeman University, will be our speaker at all services. In addition to his teaching and administrative work at FHU, Billy is one of the pulpit ministers of the Estes Church of Christ at Henderson, Tennessee, where a large number of university students worship.
