# Two Lessons From Timothy

Today's sermons will be two lessons from 2 Timothy. The morning sermon will be "Approved To God," from 2 Timothy 2: 14-19. The passage gives us some characteristics of faithful Christians and then discusses the conduct of faithful Christians (2: 15). Then the text discusses the characteristics of false teachers and gives us two examples (vs. 14, 16-18). Finally there is a section on the foundation of God (v. 19).

The evening sermon is "The Lord's Servant," taken from 2 Timothy 2: 20-26. It deals with useful vessels (vs. 20-23) and useful servants (vs. 24-26). These two lessons will complete our study of the first two chapters of 2 Timothy. Soon we will return to our sermons from 2 Timothy as we begin to study the third chapter of this great (and likely last) letter of Paul, sometimes called "Paul's last will and testament."

It was a wonderful occasion and we appreciate everyone and everything that was a part of it. We are about to enjoy a few days off, but we are already looking forward to being back and getting back into the swing of things.

The early church, as it was "scattered went everywhere preaching the word" (Acts 8: 4). God sent Paul "to preach the gospel" (1 Cor. 1: 17).

Why is preaching so important? Because "it pleased God through the foolishness of the message preached to save those who believe" (1 Cor. 1: 21). Thus Paul "determined not to know anything among you except Jesus Christ and Him crucified" (1 Cor. 2: 2). How did Paul communicate that message? Through his preaching and writing. "Preach the word!"

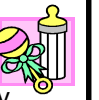
