More on Resurrection

Both of the sermons today will continue our study of the resurrection. The morning sermon deals with "The Resurrection Body" (1 Cor. 15:35-49). The evening lesson will discuss "The Resurrection Promise" (1 Cor. 15:50-58). These and the sermon scheduled for next Sunday morning, "The Resurrection Life" (Phil. 3:20-21), will conclude our series of six sermons on the resurrection. I hope the series has been a blessing to you. I know it has to me.

In this morning's sermon we will ask three questions: (1) What is resurrection? (2) What were the questions Paul asked in reference to the resurrection? (3) What is the evidence for the resurrection body? Tonight's lesson will be divided into two parts: (1) The Change (vs. 50-56), and (2) The Conclusion (vs. 57-58).

I want to say a personal word to you about church attendance. I know that we are all very busy people and that many important things vie for our time and attention. However, it is hard to believe that anything is more important than our regular attendance at all services of the church, including both worship periods and Bible classes.

Why is attendance so important? Here are two reasons. One, I believe that Hebrews 10:25 is a commandment, though I am aware that not everyone agrees. The immediate context (Heb. 10:19-24) encourages us to be faithful. Part of our faithfulness is faithful attendance at worship. We are not to forsake the assembly, but are to assemble to encourage one another (Heb. 10:25). Two, worship attendance encourages spiritual growth (Eph. 4:13; 2 Pet. 3:18). All Christians need to attend all periods of worship and Bible study if possible.
