GRACE

From A. D. 60 to 62 the Apostle Paul was under house arrest in Rome (Acts 28:16-31). During that time, he wrote at least four letters, known collectively as “the prison epistles.” These were Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians and Philemon.

The theme of Ephesians is “Christ and His Church.” In Ephesians 2:1-10 Paul discusses three things: the past (2:1-3), the present (2:4-6) and the future (2:7-10). In the past, before we obeyed the gospel of Christ, we were dead (2:1), disobedient (2:2) and doomed (2:3).

In his discussion of the present, Paul reminds us that God is rich in mercy (2:4), great in love (2:4) and generous in grace (2:5). What has God done for us? He has saved us (2:5), raised us up (2:6) and “made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus “ 2:6).

In verse seven Paul again refers to God’s grace. Then he writes what is a key to the entire passage. “For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God” (2:8).

What is grace? It has often been defined as God’s unmerited favor. One scholar calls it God’s unmerited love. I once heard the great Ira North preach on grace. He defined or described it this way. “Grace is when you get what you don’t deserve and you don’t get what you do deserve.” It is hard to improve on that definition. “For by grace you have been saved through faith” (Ephesians 2:8).
