WORRY

What is worry? It is "to feel uneasy or anxious; fret; torment with or suffer from disturbing thoughts." W. E. Vine refers to worry as "to be anxious about, to have a distracting care." It is to be drawn in different directions, to be distracted, to be anxious.

Worry is a problem for many people. Jesus addressed this problem in Matthew 6:24-34. He said, "Do not worry." Or as the ESV has it, "Do not be anxious." That is a command. We are not to worry, though that is easier said than done.

To worry is to be torn apart inside. As someone put it, "I am torn all to pieces." Jesus spoke of those who worried about their lives and what they would eat, drink and wear {Matthew 6:25}.

What is the solution to the problem? Jesus stated it (Matthew 6:33). Our first priority is to seek the kingdom of God and His righteousness. We must put God in first place in our hearts, minds and lives. If we do, "All these things shall be added to you."

Jesus concludes, "Do not worry about tomorrow." Why not? Because "tomorrow will worry about its own things" (Matthew 6:34). God has repeatedly promised to take care of His children. Peter wrote of "casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you" (1 Peter 5:7).
