One concept that will be important for you to understand for this lesson is the difference between an indicative and imperative (English majors will love this!).

**Indicative** (mood of certainty, actuality):

That is a chair  
You are a holy nation, a royal priesthood

**Imperative** (mood of command):

Sit in that chair  
Be holy as I am holy

Often times we focus only on the imperatives and we neglect the indicatives. It is my prayer as we look at how we help marriages this morning that you will experience a paradigm shift and your relationship with your spouse never be the same. It's my hope that this lesson will help heal any wounds in our church family.
