God's Design for the Church

Paul's letter to the Ephesians is divided into two parts. The first three chapters are the doctrinal foundation and the last three chapters are the practical application. In the practical section Paul begins by urging us to "walk worthy of the calling with which you were called" (4:1). Then he lists several characteristics of the Christian walk or lifestyle (4:2). Next he encourages unity (4:3) and gives the basis for unity (4:4-6).

In 4:7-11 Paul discusses the spiritual gifts that came to certain first century believers from Christ. The groups listed in 4:11 are groups that had received special gifts through the laying on of the apostolic hands. This gave them the ability to lead the early church according to the will of God. Granted, we have evangelists, pastors and teachers in the church today, but they are not the same as those listed in this verse. While we do not have inspired men today we have an inspired Book, the Bible, by which Christ's church is to be guided and directed (2 Tim. 3:16-17).

This inspired Book has several purposes. It is "for the equipping of the saints, for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ" (4:12). What does God's word produce (Lk. 8:11)? (1) "The unity of the faith." (2) The full and complete "Knowledge of the Son of God." (3) A "perfect/mature man." (4) Growth "to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ" (4:13).
