“The Power of God”

The key to Romans is 1: 16-17. The gospel is “the power of God unto salvation.” It is the gospel Paul was eager to preach at Rome (1:15), the gospel he was obligated to preach (1:14), and the gospel of which he was not ashamed (1:16). What does Romans 1:16-17 teach about the gospel?

First, the CONTENT of the gospel is “good news.” It is the good news of the death, burial and resurrection of Christ (1 Cor. 15:1-4). However, the gospel includes all of God’s good news that is revealed to us in Scripture. It is the good news of redemption and salvation and fellowship with the Father and the Son.

Second, why is the gospel such good news? What CAUSES it to be good news? The gospel message is good news because it is based on and results from the power of God.

Third, what is the CONCERN of the gospel? It concerns our salvation. What is salvation? It is freedom or deliverance from sin. “Salvation and glory and honor and power belong to the Lord our God” (Rev. 9:1).

Finally, salvation is CONDITIONAL. There are certain things required of us (Mt. 7:21; Jn. 14:15). Salvation comes only to one who believes. But the word “believes” includes all that is necessary for our salvation. This includes not only faith, but also repentance, confession and baptism, all of which are a part of the gospel of God. The gospel is the good news of the power of God unto salvation to all who believe and obey it.
