# CHRISTIAN WORLDVIEW

Several weeks ago a dear friend spent three days helping me install 1200 feet of water pipe to get water from the road to our new house. While I could say, "I am a plumber," it certainly doesn't make me a plumber. Likewise, many people say they are "Christian," but the truth reveals otherwise.

Barna Research group took a survey and found that only 4% of Americans hold to a Biblical worldview---and yet everyone believes they are saved. How could that be?

In Matthew 7: 13-14 Jesus observed, "Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it."

Three points for you to consider: (1) There is a narrow gate---and thus, not everyone is going to heaven; (2) There is a difficult (or narrow) path that leads to the narrow gate; and (3) the broad way does not lead to the narrow gate.

We have all heard about the narrow gate, but we don't talk much about the narrow or difficult path. Is it possible that some of our children are being baptized and come out of the water only to begin walking on the broad path? Consider for a moment what path you're on and what worldview your children are embracing. Don't just say, "I'm a Christian." Be one.
