PEACE

What is peace? The word refers to the harmonious relationship between God and man that is accomplished through the gospel of Christ. It is the sense of rest and contentment that comes from a right relationship with God through His Son (John 14:6; Acts 4:12). As Paul puts it, "Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ" (Romans 5:1).

From where does peace come? It comes from God. We can never have true peace without a right relationship with God that can only come through Christ. Paul wrote of "the peace of God" (Philippians 4:7). The scholars call that the genitive of source. It means that true peace comes from our Father in heaven. It "surpasses all comprehension" (NASB). It rises above and is superior to our understanding. However, we do not have to completely understand it to accept it. It is given to us by God through Christ.

What does this peace from God do? It "will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus" (Philippians 4:7). "Guard" is a military term. The peace that comes from God builds a fortress around us that protects our hearts (our emotions) and our minds (our intellect). Only God can provide this peace and it only comes from Him through Christ. It comes by obedience to the gospel (Romans 1:16-17). Are you a Christian? Become one now by obeying the gospel of Christ.
