The words of Paul in Romans 12:17-21 are among the most challenging in the New Testament. He wrote, **“Repay no one evil for evil. Have regard for good things in the sight of all men. If it is possible, as much as depends on you, live peaceably with all men. Beloved, do not avenge yourselves, but rather give place to wrath; for it is written, ‘Vengeance is Mine, I will repay,’ says the Lord. Therefore ‘If your enemy is hungry, feed him; If he is thirsty, give him a drink; For in so doing you will heap coals of fire on his head.’ Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good”** (Romans 12:17-21). The command given here goes against our natural instincts. We often feel justified in harming someone if they have harmed us first. Paul taught that we must deny our natural tendencies to live as God would intend. One of the clearest ways of doing this is by overcoming evil with good.
