## Get Rid of “Except”

In 2 Kings 15:1-4 we read about the reign of Azariah, King of Judah. This passage says: **“In the twenty-seventh year of Jeroboam king of Israel, Azariah the son of Amaziah, king of Judah, became king. He was sixteen years old when he became king, and he reigned fifty-two years in Jerusalem. His mother's name was Jecholiah of Jerusalem. And he did what was right in the sight of the LORD, according to all that his father Amaziah had done, except that the high places were not removed; the people still sacrificed and burned incense on the high places.”** A very important word in this passage is the word “except”. I want you to notice that Azariah did a lot of good things; however, he still allowed some idolatrous practices. If you were to keep reading you would see that God punished him. This is a good time to ask, is there an “except” in your life? Could it be said that you follow Christ... except... you don't love your enemies, you complain when things don't go your way, or anything else like this? Let us get rid of the “excepts” in our lives. Let us follow Christ completely.
