~ Why We Worship ~

Last week in the morning sermon we saw "Who We Worship." This morning we will see "Why We Worship." A lawyer asked Jesus "Teacher, which is the great commandment in the law?" Jesus answered "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the first and great commandment" (Mt. 22: 34-38).

Why do we worship God? Because we love God. Why do we love God? Because "He first loved us" (1 Jn. 4: 19) and sent His Son to save us from sin (Jn. 3: 16). Because God loves us He not only wants us to love Him, He also wants us to worship Him (Jn. 4: 23). In fact, we are to worship and serve only Him (Mt. 4: 10). How are we to worship Him? "In spirit and truth" (Jn. 4: 24).

It is our love for God that is a response to His love for us that motivates us to worship Him in spirit and truth. The Bible emphasizes God's love for us in many passages. His love for us is continually demonstrated by the death of Christ (Rom. 5: 8). "He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins" (1 Jn. 4: 10).

God loves us. We love Him. Therefore, we worship Him in spirit and truth. As one preacher used to say, "God loved you. Love Him back."
