Joseph and His Brothers

Joseph is one of the more well-known Bible characters. You might remember that when Joseph was a young man his brothers, filled with hate, plotted to kill him. Yet after his brothers discussed their plot together, they reasoned that killing him would bring them no benefit; therefore, they sold him into slavery instead. Joseph, a godly man, gained great respect while in slavery so that he was eventually made a ruler in the land of Egypt. Years later he encountered his brothers. They were terrified of how Joseph might repay them. Yet “Joseph said to them, ‘Do not be afraid, for am I in the place of God? But as for you, you meant evil against me; but God meant it for good, in order to bring it about as it is this day, to save many people alive. Now therefore, do not be afraid; I will provide for you and your little ones.’ And he comforted them and spoke kindly to them” (Genesis 50:19-21). When we have an opportunity for retribution, let us ask the same question, “am I in the place of God?” Let us learn from the example of Joseph.
