CONSIDER CHRIST

There are many reasons why the Bible was written. One is to show the existence and work of God. Another is to show that Jesus is the Son of God. A third is to show man God's plan for the redemption and salvation of our souls.

Consider the place of Jesus Christ in our salvation. (1) He is the Son of God and Savior of the world (Mt. 16:16; Rom. 1:4; Jn. 4:42; Lk. 19:10). (2) We must understand that only He can save us (Jn. 14: 6; Acts 4:12). (3) We must believe in Him as the Son of God (Jn. 8: 24). (4) We must come to Him for salvation (Mt. 11: 28-30). (5) We must obey Him (Jn. 14:15; Mt. 7:21). (6) To obey Him is to obey His gospel (Rom. 1:16-17; Mk. 16:15-16).

We obey His gospel by faith (Heb. 11:1, 6), repentance (Lk. 13:1-5), confession (Rom. 10:10), and baptism by immersion for the remission of our sins (Rom. 6: 1-4; Gal. 3: 26-27; Acts 2: 38).

The solution to sin is Jesus Christ, who is the Son of God and Savior of the world. He is the Messiah (Mt. 16: 16), Emmanuel (Mt. 1: 23; Phil. 2: 5-11), the Son of Man (Lk. 19 10), the Savior (Jn. 4: 42), and "The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!" (Jn. 1: 29). He calls us through the gospel (2 Th. 2: 14) to salvation (Rom. 1:16-17). The gospel is God's inspired word (2 Tim. 3:16-17; Jn. 17:17), the truth that sets us free from sin (Jn. 8: 32).

FREEDOM FROM SIN

What is sin? It is a failure to live in harmony with the will of God as that will is revealed in God's inspired word, the Bible (2 Tim. 3: 16-17). The only One who can free us from sin is Jesus Christ, the Son of God (Mt. 16: 16; Jn. 14:6; Acts 4:12).

We are freed from sin by the blood of Jesus Christ which was shed on the cross (Eph. 1:7; Col. 1:14; Mt. 26:28). We are freed from sin when we obey the gospel of Christ (Rom. 1:16-17; Gal. 5:1; Rom. 6:1-4). We are called to salvation by the gospel of Christ (2 Th 2:14). It is imperative that we obey the gospel if we want to be freed from sin (2 Th. 1: 7-9; 1 Pt. 4:17).

The gospel that calls us is the gospel by which we will be judged (Rev. 20: 11-15). It is God's inspired word (1 Cor. 2:13), the truth (Jn. 17:17) that guides us (Ps. 119: 105), and sets us free (Jn. 8:32; Gal. 5:1).

We must hear (Rom 10:17), believe (Heb. 11: 6; Jn. 8:24), repent (Acts 17: 30-31), confess Christ (Rom. 10: 10), and be immersed for the remission of our sins (Acts 2: 38). By this Christ adds us to His church (Acts 2: 47).
