MISSIONS MEMO.....



The Ferguson Family Chimala, Tanzania

The Ferguson Family is currently in the United States for a well-deserved furlough after three years in Tanzania. While in the US, the Fergusons have been busy traveling to supporting congregations from Missouri to Tennessee to the New England states.

They visited at Southern Hills for our evening service on Sunday, September 10 to report on the work in Tanzania.

Some of the recent successes in Tanzania include the Youth Seminar from June 5-9 where 5 new souls were added to the Lord's church. The following week was a Ladies Seminar from June 12-16. This was the largest attendance on record, with 197 attending. These women came from 9 regions and from a total of 57 congregations. Finally, a Preachers Seminar was held June 19-22 with 79 preachers attending from 54 congregations representing 11 regions across the country.

Even though the Fergusons are away from Chimala, the mission is still busy as fire breaks are being made, eggs are being laid, crops are being harvested, animals are growing, and the mission continues its efforts to be self-sufficient. The Fergusons will be returning to Tanzania early next month.
