Roles of Elders

Last Sunday Garrett preached a sermon on the requirements for those who would serve as elders in the Lord's church. Today I will preach on the roles and responsibilities of those who are elders. We will study two passages from the New Testament that deal with those responsibilities: I Peter 5:1-4 and Acts 20:28-32.

I Peter 5:1-4 contains some prohibitions and some obligations that the elders owe the church. The elders are to "shepherd the flock of God which is among you, serving as overseers" (v 2). But elders are not to serve "by constraint but willingly" (v 2), they are to some "not for dishonest gain but eagerly" (v 2), and not "as being lords over those entrusted to you but being examples of the flock" (v 3).

Acts 20:28-32 says that elders are to "take heed to yourselves and all the flock" (v 28). They are to be "overseers" and "shepherds" over the church. They are to always be on guard against false teachers and false teaching (vs 29-30), they are to continually "watch" (v 31).

These are among the several requirements God has for those who lead His church. We will discuss them further in today's lesson.
