HEAVEN

The Bible may not tell us a lot about heaven, but what is there gives us a vivid picture of what heaven will be like. This morning we will examine two passages of Scripture: John 14: 1-3 and Revelation 21: 1-7. Each passage tells us some very important things about heaven.

First we will study John 14: 1-3. There Jesus tells us that in His Father's house there are many "mansions." Some translations use the word "dwellings," "dwelling places," "abiding places," "rooms," or "abodes." The word is used here of "heavenly dwellings" (BAGD). The idea is one of permanence. Heaven is the eternal home of the redeemed.

The second passage at which we will look is Revelation 21: 1-7, which tells us some very important things about heaven. (1) Heaven is "new" (v. 1). The word describes something that is "new as to form or quality," as opposed to that which is old. Heaven is a new place, unlike anything we have experienced before. (2) Heaven is compared to "a bride adorned for her husband" (v. 2). It is compared to a bride in all of her radiance and beauty. Heaven will be a beautiful place.

(3) Heaven is the place where God will be with us and we with him (v. 3). (4) Heaven is the place where there will be no tears, death, sorrow, crying or pain (v. 4). (5) Heaven is the place where God will be our God and we will be His children.
