What is salvation? It is freedom or deliverance from sin. How does it come about? Through the blood of Christ shed on the cross (Ephesians 1:7; Colossians 1:14). What does the Bible say about salvation?

First, salvation comes from God. He is the "God of our salvation" (1 Chronicles 16:35; Psalm 68:19-20). The psalmist refers to salvation as "His salvation" (Psalm 98:2), and as "My salvation" (Isaiah 51:4). Isaiah also writes of "the salvation of our God" (Isaiah 52:10). Nowhere is the source of our salvation made clearer than in Isaiah 53.

Second, salvation comes through Jesus Christ (John 14:6; Acts 4:12). He "is indeed the Christ, the Savior of the world" (John 4:42). He came to "save His people from their sins" (Matthew 1:21). He came "to give knowledge of salvation to His people by the remission of their sins" (Luke 1:77).

Third, salvation comes when we obey the gospel (Acts 2:38). Why? Because the gospel of Christ is "the power of God to salvation" (Romans 1:16-17). Our Savior is Jesus Christ (Acts 13:23). He is the only Savior (John 14:6). Christ died for us (Romans 5:8). We are "justified by His blood" (Romans 5:9). Jesus came "to seek and to save the lost" (Luke 19:10).

How do we receive salvation? It comes from God through Christ by obedience to the gospel (Romans 10:17; John 8:24; Luke 13:1-5; Romans 10:10; Acts 2:38). We urge and encourage you to become a Christian today if you have not yet obeyed the gospel.
