~ UNBELIEF ~

Webster defines unbelief as "incredulity or skepticism in matters of religious faith...the attitude or state of mind of one who does not believe" and notes that it is the opposite of belief. It was the state of mind of the father who brought his demon-possessed son to Jesus in Mark 9:14-29. The man had asked the disciples to help the boy, but they could not. So he turned to Jesus, saying, "If you can do anything, have compassion on us and help us." To this Jesus responded, "If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes" (Mk. 9:23 NKJV).

Then the desperate father cried out and said with tears, "Lord, I believe; help my unbelief!" Do you ever feel that way? I do not mean that you do not believe at all, but is your faith ever weak and uncertain? If it is, do not be embarrassed or ashamed. You are not alone. There are others who sometimes feel that way, too.

This morning's sermon will look at Mark 9:14-29. We will see (1) The Scene (9:14-16), (2) The Situation (9:17-24), and (3) The Solution (9:25-29). After a study of the text we will make application to our own lives. Do we ever struggle with unbelief? What causes such a struggle? What do we do about it? Is there some magic formula involved, or is the solution rather simple? God has provided His solution for us. We will see what that is in the lesson this morning.
