Use Your Talents!

The Bible teaches us that every good gift comes from God (James 1:17). It also says that we are to do all that we do to the glory of God (1 Corinthians 10:31). We are to be good stewards of all that God has given us, including our talents and abilities (1 Corinthians 4:2).

Jesus taught a great lesson about using our talents in His service (Matthew 25:14-30). A man about to go to a far country gave one servant five talents, another two, and a third one, "each according to his own ability". The first two men doubled their talents, but the third "went and dug in the ground and hid his Lord's money".

When the lord of those servants returned, he called the three men to settle accounts with them. The first two were praised for having doubled their talents, but the third was condemned for hiding his talent in the ground. The talent was taken from him and given to the man with ten talents.

What are the lessons? We must fulfill our responsibilities as stewards of the talents God has given us. We must be workers in the kingdom. We should take inventory of our talents and be busy for Christ. We all have gifts (1 Peter 4:10). We have different gifts (Romans 12:6-8). We must use our gifts or talents properly.

We should each be concerned with what gifts we have and how best to use those gifts to the glory of God. The best way to be ready for the return of our Lord is to be busy at all times. Finally, we must remember that our work for Him is never finished. There is no retirement from His service.
