When Paul wrote to the church at Galatia he warned them about the works of the flesh. He said this “Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told you in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God” (Galatians 5:19-21). It is interesting that in a list of things such as: adultery, hatred, and murder we find “selfish ambitions.” Sadly, we do not usually think of selfishness as a terrible sin. Many actually consider it good. How often do we hear advice like “you do what is best for you”? Consider all the harm selfishness causes. When people steal, cheat, lie, and hurt others it’s because they are selfish. Let us look out for others and never act out of selfish ambition.

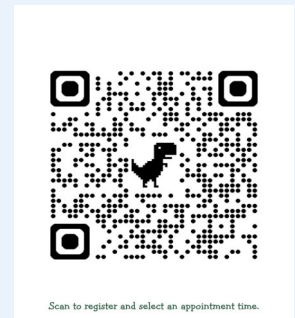
