### **Kilimanjaro Missions Noel Stafford & Family Tanzania, East Africa**

October was a FULL month at Kilimanjaro Missions. The radio program continues to have a lot of listener involvement. We have recently had many questions about the topic of baptism.

The evangelism work in Moshi and Boma Ng'ombe continues, and we are seeing good growth.

Also, some of our Kilimanjaro ladies had an opportunity to attend a seminar in Arusha this month, and the Kilimanjaro men held their monthly fellowship meal and meeting at a member's home, followed by evangelism in the neighborhood.

One of our new sisters, Monica is the caretaker for several street children. She diligently brings them to worship every Sunday. The children love attending Bible class and also pay attention in worship services. This is such a wonderful opportunity to teach them at a young age.

The Kilimanjaro church of Christ held its annual campaign in Moshi. There was great involvement from the congregation. The campaign was a 3-day event. Each morning, 20-30 Christians met at the Bible school to pray before heading out to evangelize.

Afterwards we made our way to the center of Moshi for the daily preaching. We had 2 immediate baptisms and began several bible studies from this campaign.

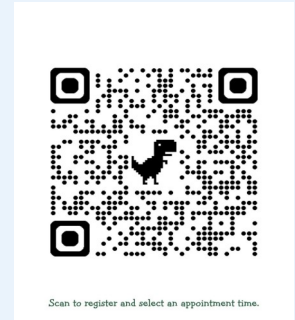
